### **Hey Scouts! It's Camping Time!!!**

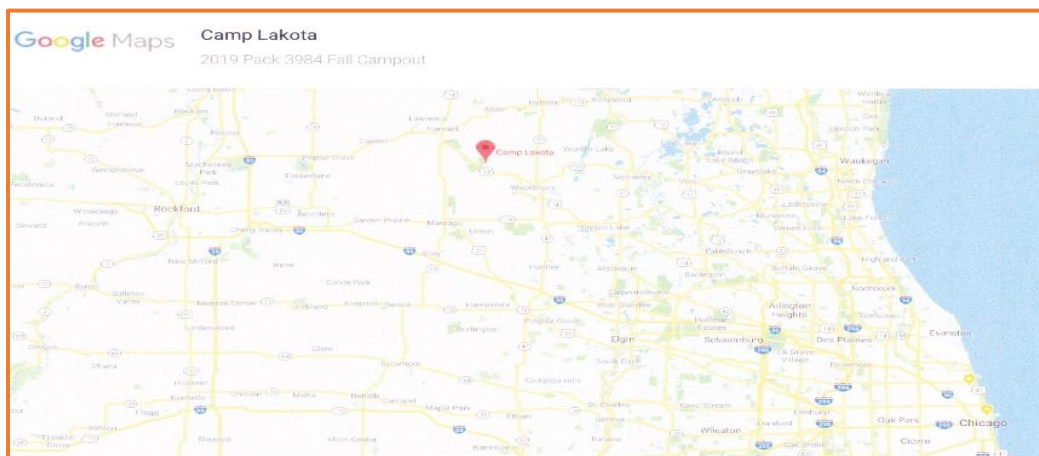

**Address:** 2050 Deep Cut Rd, Woodstock, IL 60098

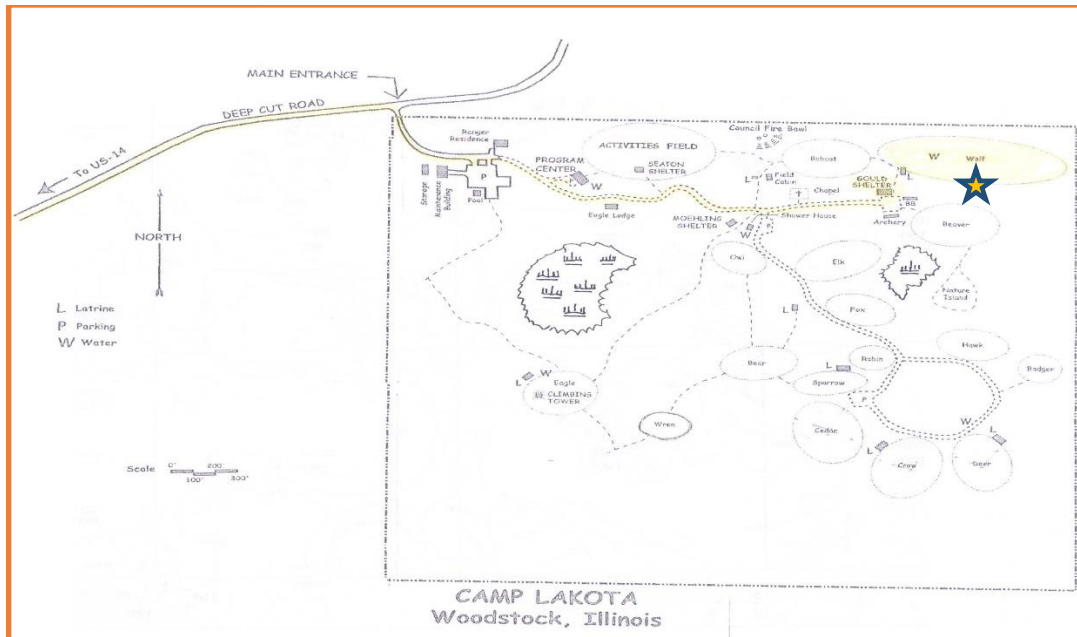
### **Campground Location on Map:**

## Youth Protection Training:

All adults over 18 must have a valid YPT certification. Once taken, this is good for 2 years. If you are new to the pack, you need to take this online course in order to camp or any outdoor scout activity. Please set up an account and take the YPT course.
